A selection of freshly baked breads and delicious sandwiches. Try its very unique ice cream flavor, too! (Open 10:00-16:00)




10 Inaho Farmers Market

High-quality soba (buckwheat), udon (Japanese wheat) and ramen noodles. (Open 10:30-17:30)


16 Kanade (Japanese restaurant)
